SNAP Members Print Exchange 2020 Guidelines

Submissions to the SNAP Members Print Exchange must comply with all guidelines. Any edition that fails to meet one or more of the guidelines will be returned to the printmaker with an accompanying explanation.

Please make sure that you have read and followed the guidelines before submitting your print edition. If you have any queries please email Amanda McKenzie printshop@snapartists.com for clarification.

Members Print Exchange Guidelines

1. Original Work

All work submitted must be created specifically for the SNAP print exchange and, as a contributing artist, you must own the intellectual property rights for all images submitted.

2. Theme

The theme is *In Place*, with the intention of considering the following ideas of staying in place, in place of, or connecting to the place you're in.

This theme should be interpreted broadly to encompass anything the artist feels relates and in response to the current global health situation, their own experiences, or just the act of creating at home and without a community of artists and a printshop physically present. We ask that participating artists consider being *In Place* as well as ways to continue engaging with printmaking and how to do this at home.

3. Membership

You must have a current SNAP Membership to participate. You may purchase or renew before submitting at snapartists.com/membership/

4. Paper Sized

Exactly 8 x 10 inches. No bigger. No smaller. Measure twice, tear paper (hopefully) once.

5. **Edition Size**

Six (6) prints, one of which will be retained by SNAP for their Print Archive

6. **Print Medium**

All submissions must be created using an *editionable** print technique. This exchange **does not exclude** digital inkjet prints (*do note that SNAP's digital printing services are not currently available*) **and does not exclude** prints created through a combination of different print techniques.

All printmaking techniques and processes are welcome, but please ensure that your prints are printed using high quality printmaking materials, acid-free paper, and archival inks*

**While we are printing at home and under some experimental printing circumstances, our definition of an "edition" will remain approximate rather than precise. As well our definition of "high quality" will remain flexible. Do your best!*

7. **Signing and Editioning**

All prints must be signed, editioned, and dated. This may be on the front or back of the print.

8. **Paper Selection**

All prints must be printed on high quality* paper acid free paper appropriate to the print medium.

**While we are printing at home and under some experimental printing circumstances, our definition of "high quality" will remain flexible. Do your best!*

9. **Print Presentation**

Each print must be fully dry and individually protected by glassine paper if heavily inked or prone to scuffing/transfer.

10. **Submission Deadline**

May 30, 2020 by 6 pm - SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITH NOTICE

11. **Submission Form**

Complete the online Google Submission Form with your personal information (name, biography, applicable website or social media links, address, and email) and the checklist. **Link will be shared when you express interest by April 30, 2020*

12. **Postage Fee**

If the participant lives outside of Edmonton and will not be picking up their prints
